All divisions are open to all ages. If you are entering as a Junior or Professional, place the appropriate letter on the entry form under sub-category. A professional is someone who sells or instructs.

**SUB-CATEGORIES: (If sub-category is not specified, entry will be classified as “Open”).**

- A: Junior, ages 8 and under
- B: Junior, ages 9 through 13
- C: Junior, ages 14 through 17
- P: Professional

## SIZE REQUIREMENTS:

Maximum size is 60 united inches including the frame.

(example: height + width: 24+36 = 60 united inches)

Minimum size is 18 united inches

(example: height + width: 8+10 = 18 united inches)

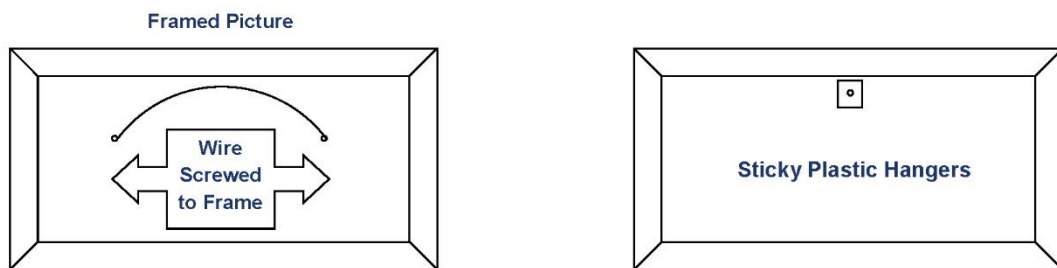
## FRAMING REQUIREMENTS:

All frames must be able to be hung with screwed hangers and wire. Canvases that are gallery wrapped, at least 3/4" deep, with painted edges can be framed or unframed. String, fishing line, yarn, rope, cardboard hooks, saw tooth hangers, or taped wire is not acceptable.

Junior entries need to be on finished edge, gallery wrapped canvases with wire to hang, or framed. Drawings, watercolor, pastel, charcoal can be framed in inexpensive, light weight photo frames with sticky hangers or wire hangers.

All Open and Professional entries must be framed in a sturdy wood or metal frame under glass. Oil and acrylic paintings need not be under glass.

## ACCEPTABLE



Work will be judged on design, composition, originality, creativity, color saturation, lighting, contrast emotional response, technical expertise, and craftsmanship. Entries in the Professional Division will also be judged on presentation.

Art must be original: no copies or kits will be accepted. Art must be painted within the last two years. The superintendent reserves the full right not to hang or judge any entry. The Fair is not responsible for frames damaged during handling or hanging; every measure is made to prevent injury to artwork.

Pay special attention to size and framing requirements. Entries not meeting any and all requirements (including framing requirements) will be disqualified. Disqualified entries will not be judged, however, if space permits may be displayed.
