Entries must have finished bottoms; and need to be finished on the inside. Entrant must be the primary creator, designer or decorator of the piece. Entries previously judged are not allowed. Due to display space limitation, we will not accept ceiling or wall hanging submissions. *Entries with electrical cords and lights will be disqualified.
