- **1st Entry:** Tuesday, August 20,
4 pm – 8 pm *Division 1 & 2*
- **2nd Entry:** Tuesday, August 27,
4 pm – 8 pm *Division 3 - 5 and 4-H*

Exhibitors may enter two animals per class. A veterinarian at the north door of Farm Exhibits will check all animals during entry times. Unhealthy, pregnant, or rabbits under eight weeks may be sent home by the superintendent or the veterinarian. Bring animals groomed for show. Cages do not need to be reserved; food is provided. Judging follows the ARBA Book of Standards. Daily care of entries provided by the Fair herdsman and attendants.

DIVISION 04: CAVY / GUINEA PIGS

Limit two per cage.

Class:

- 01 Sr. Boar, 6 months or over
- 02 Jr. Boar, 8 weeks through 5 months

- 04 Jr. Sow, 8 weeks through 5 months

DIVISION 05: MEAT

Judged on type, condition, and uniformity

Class:

- 01 Meat Pen - Three of same breed and variety. Different litters okay. Up to 10 weeks; 3 to 5 pounds. Limit three per pen.
- 02 Single Fryer - up to 10 weeks, 5 pounds, one per pen
- 03 Roaster - under 6 months, 5.5 - 9 pounds, one per pen
- 04 Stewer - minimum 6 months, minimum 8 pounds, one per pen
