1. All entries must include a completed Quilt Department Information Form ([click here](#)).
 2. All entries must be constructed of three layers of material with quilting that binds all three layers together.
 3. All entries must be clean and free of stains: no pet hair, no odors (including perfume, fabric softeners, odor-masking sprays, etc.)
 4. All entries must appear new and unused.
 5. All hanging rods, wires, sticks, hooks, or other display mechanisms are not permitted.
 6. Any quilt completed since the 2025 Alaska State Fair (ASF) is eligible for entry.
 7. The Superintendent may correct miscategorized entries.
 8. All Divisions are open to all Sub-Categories (A, B, C, & Open). Please indicate the Sub-Category on all entry forms. Entries will be classified as Open if no Sub-Category is indicated.
 9. Entries which are determined to be ineligible for competition will be returned to the Entrant at the time of submission or excluded from judging and held in secure storage by the ASF until the Exhibit Pick-up Dates noted above.
 10. Entries without entrant contact/ mailing information will be automatically excluded from judging.
 11. Yo-Yo and Tied Quilts may be submitted to the Sewing Department. Crazy Quilts may be submitted to the Handwork & Needlework Department.

Sub-Categories:

A – Junior, ages 12 and under

B – Junior, ages 13-17

C – Adult Beginner, 18 and over with less than 5 years quilting experience

Open – Adult Open, 18 and over with 5 years or more quilting experience
(Everyone who has entered a quilt in the ASF from 1936-2021)

Definitions

Bed Quilts – All quilt sides are between 70" and 95" in length.

Beginner – Entrants who have been working with quilt making for less than 5 years.

Group – Quilts made by two or more people.

Lap Quilts – All quilt sides are between 45" and 70" in length.

Large Bed Quilts - No quilt side is shorter than 95" in length.

Miniature - Miniatures are more than one block, scaled down proportionately and representational of a larger quilt.

Open – Entrants who have been working with quilt making for 5 years or more (All Entrants who have participated in Quilts Competitive Exhibits at the Alaska State Fair from 1936 to 2021 will be classified as Open.

Quilting Experience – For the purpose of quilt entries at the Alaska State Fair, experience is defined as an active focus on practicing the art and craft of quilting. If you have been actively dabbling in quilt making off and on for 5 years or more, we ask that you enter in Sub-Category Open.

Solo – Quilts made by only one person.

Wall Hangings – No quilt side exceeds 45" in length.
