Unhealthy, pregnant, or rabbits under eight weeks may be sent home by the superintendent or the veterinarian. Bring animals groomed for show. Cages do not need to be reserved; food is provided. Judging follows the ARBA Book of Standards. Daily care of entries provided by the Fair herdsman and attendants.

- 03 Roaster - under 6 months, 5.5 - 9 pounds, one per pen
- 04 Stewer - minimum 6 months, minimum 8 pounds, one per pen
